- 5) Applicant must have applied on the Form made available through The Cal Kimura Memorial Scholarship via the Kapa'a High School Foundation, available at the counselors' office or online at the Kapa'a High School Foundation's website or official Facebook or Instagram page.
- 6) Applicants must submit, along with the Application Form, a Resume summarizing the applicant's academic, extracurricular & community activities.
- 7) One letter of recommendation based on community service participation.
- 8) One-page type written double space personal essay addressing career plans, how this scholarship will enhance future goals and what I want to do in the future to give back to the Kaua'i community.
- 9) These documents should be legible, properly sealed and sent with the application form or by email with attached scanned documents. See specific return instructions provided on page 2 of this document.
