

DANIEL S. HAMADA ENDOWMENT 2022 SCHOLARSHIP Via Kapa'a High School Foundation

The Daniel S. Hamada Endowment Scholarship Award will award up to three scholarships of \$1,000.00 each to Kapa'a High School Class of 2022 students. Awardees shall have demonstrated academic growth aligned with their current Academy career field of interest. Awardees will also need to demonstrate a high level of meaningful participation in volunteer and community service activities. Scholarship recipients shall have established acceptance to Kauai Community College along with a high school cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher.

This marks the 3rd year for the Daniel S. Hamada Endowment Scholarship award in partnership with the Kapa'a High School Foundation focused on students' career plans aligned with their current high school Academy work.

Scholarship applications are available at the Kapa'a High School counselors' office or online at the Kapa'a High School Foundation's website http://kapaahighschoolfoundation.org or official Facebook page. All applications must be received by **Monday, April 11, 2022**.

Terms of Application for Scholarships

- 1. Applicant must be a senior at Kapa'a High School.
- 2. Applicant shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Hawai'i.
- 3. Applicant shall be accepted at Kauai Community College by Spring 2022.
- 4. Applicant shall have a grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
- 5. If awarded, the individual must email a brief write up and photo describing the scholarship's impact after starting at the higher learning institution for posting on the Kapa'a High School Foundation's website.
- 6. Applicant must have applied on the application form made available through the Daniel S. Hamada Endowment Scholarship via Kapa'a High School Foundation, available at the counselors' office or online at the Kapa'a High School Foundation's website or official Facebook page.
- 7. Applicants must submit, along with the application form, a resume summarizing the applicant's academic, extracurricular & community activities; one letter of recommendation based on community service participation; and a one-page personal essay addressing career plans, as part of the complete application.
- 8. These documents should be legible, properly attached to the Application Form. Return instructions are provided on page 2 of this document.

Deadline for applications is **Monday April 11, 2022**. **NO LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. RESPONSIBILITY FOR TIMELY SUBMISSION RESTS WITH THE APPLICANT.**
