



## **LTC PLACIDO & MICHELLE VALENCIANO 2022 JUNIOR ROTC SCHOLARSHIP via Kapa'a High School Foundation**

The LTC Placido & Michelle Valenciano Jr ROTC Scholarship will award \$500 to a deserving student of Kapa'a High School, class of 2022, to be disbursed by the Kapa 'a High School Foundation Scholarship Committee.

An additional \$500.00 Scholarship may be added if there is more than one exceptional candidate.

### **Terms of Application for Scholarship**

1. Applicant is a senior in good standing at Kapa'a High School.
2. Applicant must be an active member of the Kapa'a High School JROTC program and has been accepted into a two- or four-year college. Winners of a four-year ROTC Scholarship or Military Academy appointment are not eligible.
3. One-page resume, Arial 12 point, to include full name, permanent mailing address and email contact; may include accomplishments, membership into any organizations and extra-curricular activities.
4. A one-to-two-page handwritten essay on college ruled paper on the following subject: "Should people in the military be discharged from service if they refuse to be vaccinated for COVID-19. What exceptions should be approved? Please explain your answer and reasoning."
5. Applicant must complete the application form through The LTC Placido & Michelle Valenciano Jr. ROTC Scholarship via the Kapa'a High School Foundation, available at the counselors' office or online at the Kapa'a High School Foundation's website: <http://kapaahighfoundation.org> or official Facebook page.
6. Applicants understand that if the initial scholarship recipient receives either a Four-Year ROTC Scholarship or Military Academy Appointment, the award will be voided and given to the next selected finalist.

These documents should be legible and sent with properly attached documents. See specific return instructions provided on page 2 of this document.
